TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

- 1. Bids will be accepted through the website following the bidding process described in the 'How To Bid' page.
- 2. Payment should be received within 7 days of being notified of a successful bid. Payment can be made through the website using a PayPal account, or by credit card through PayPal. These payments will be subject to a surcharge of 1.4% + 20p per transaction. Alternatively, payment can be made by cheque payable to "The Heather Trust", or by direct bank transfer.
- 3. If full payment has not been received within two weeks of notification, the sale may be rescinded without any notice being given to the buyer. The property of a Lot purchased shall not pass to the buyer until he/she has made payment in full.
- 4. All successful bidders will be notified immediately on completion of the Sale by email, and the bidder will be put in contact with the donor after payment has been received
- 5. All Lots are sold according to the descriptions, which are subject to alteration until the point of sale.
